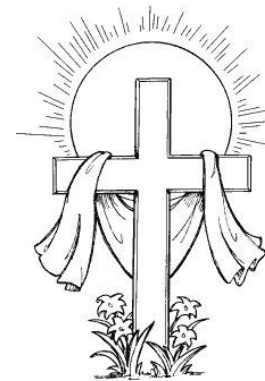
When through the woods and forest glades I
